Of Note CFMTA/FCAPM Monthly Memo

The Covid-19 pandemic has brought a number of concerns to the fore, not the least of which is the question of insurance coverage. In the June issue, we informed you that our insurer does not cover liability for exposure to Covid-19. While CFMTA/FCAPM is currently exploring options for protecting our members and their students, it must be noted that **no insurer** is willing to cover this risk, no matter the profession or the circumstances. As well, the fee for the CFMTA/FCAPM group liability insurance plan administered by Westland Insurance is \$40 per year. Other liability insurance fees run from \$500 per year for counselors to up to \$1000 per year for hairstylists. It is worth noting that those insurers will not cover illness caused by Covid-19.

The CFMTA/FCAPM Executive Committee has agreed to engage the law firm of BD Oakes, Jardine, Kaneski of Winnipeg, Manitoba to craft a waiver that will legally protect individual members who decide to return to in-person music lessons. Both the waiver and an explanatory note are forthcoming--stay tuned to the CFMTA/FCAPM website for more information.

We all want to reopen our studios. We all want to see our student's shining faces without the hazy filter of a computer screen or the indifferent sound of video conferencing. But reopening our studios must be taken with carefully calculated steps. In the meantime, wash your hands, wear a mask, follow your provincial/territorial and municipal guidelines, *be kind*. If we lose our humanity, then the virus will have won.
